Research Grants & Fellowships in the USA

Fulbright is now accepting applications for the 2013-14 Fulbright Awards for Research and/or Lecturing in the US.

We are seeking applications for a wide variety of subjects including:

- **Scholar Awards:** Up to five awards are offered to outstanding UK professionals or academics to undertake lecturing, research or a combination of the two in any field, at any accredited US institution for a period of three to ten months. **The award is for \$5,000 per month.**
- **American Studies Early Career Award:** One award is offered to an early career UK academic or professional to undertake lecturing, research or a combination of the two relating to American Studies for a period of three months. **The award is for \$5,000 per month.**
- **Deafness UK Research Award:** One award is offered in conjunction with Deafness Research UK to an academic to pursue laboratory based research into prevention, diagnosis or treatment of all forms of hearing impairment at any accredited US higher education institution. **The award is for the US dollar equivalent of £75,000.**
- **Diabetes UK Research Award:** One award is offered in conjunction with Diabetes UK in support of research at any accredited US institution into the clinical or biomedical aspects of diabetes or the social or economic issues faced by people living with diabetes. **The award is for the US dollar equivalent of £75,000.**
- **Fight for Sight Research Award:** One award is offered in conjunction with Fight for Sight to pursue laboratory based research into the prevention and treatment of blindness or eye disease at any accredited US higher education institution. **The award is for the US dollar equivalent of £75,000.**
- **Hubert Humphrey Public Affairs Award:** One grant is offered to a UK civil servant (at Grade 7 or above) to develop skills in operational and policy delivery through research and/or study during one semester (four months) at the [Hubert Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs](#), at the [University of Minnesota](#). **A grant of \$13,898.20 is provided as a contribution towards return travel, accommodation, sustenance, books and materials.**
- **Lloyds of London Insurance Award:** One grant is offered to a UK academic or professional to pursue research in a subject related to insurance for a period of three to nine months. **The award is for \$5,000 per month.**
- **RICS Scholar Award:** one grant is offered to an outstanding UK academic or professional for a period of three to eight months to undertake research into any one of the following topics: Building Information Modelling (BIM): Education, training and evolving service streams, Business Valuation, Corporate Real Estate, the difference in the UK versus US approach to loan security valuations, training of construction professionals, Infrastructure: Project finance and risk allocation, Land leverage dynamics in property markets. **The award is for the US dollar equivalent of £2,750 per month.**
- **Robertson Professor in British History:** This Award provides a career-development opportunity for an exceptional, early-career British Historian to teach at [Westminster College](#), Missouri for one academic year. **The grant in this category is for \$52,500. Additionally, a significant travel budget (up to \$10,000) to cover return travel for the Scholar & up to 4 dependents plus internal travel in the US for attendance at lectures and conferences.**
- **Royal College of Surgeons of England Research Award:** One award is offered in conjunction with Fulbright Royal College of Surgeons of England, to a surgeon, trainee surgeon or specialist to pursue research (that does not include clinical work, laboratory-based or otherwise) into the development of new operative techniques, improvements in patient care and recovery and/or the causes of surgical conditions and how to treat them, at any accredited US higher education institution. **The award is for the US dollar equivalent of £2,350 per month.**
- **Saltire Scholar Award:** Up to five scholarships offered to mid-career British entrepreneurs (social and commercial) & potential business leaders to participate on the [Saltire Fellowship Programme](#), which includes a 15-week intensive study period at [Babson College, USA](#). **Awards in this category cover tuition and programme fees and provide a living stipend of £9,500.**

The Application Process:

- Online application (provide biographical information, academic, research & extra-curricular accomplishments).
- Indicate one or more US host institute(s) applicant has made contact with & provide reasons for choosing institute(s).
- A personal statement & research/lecturing objective statement
- Three letters of recommendations are required.

In addition to financial support, **benefits also include** a number of memberships, sickness & accident benefit coverage, visa sponsorship, substantial pre-departure support, including a Finalists Workshop (March) & a 3-day Orientation Programme (July). Once on-the-ground in the US, further support is offered by the [Council for the International Exchange of Scholars \(CIES\)](#), & additional travel grant opportunities are available to accept guest lecturing invitations at other US institutions.



Fully-funded Scholarships for Postgraduate Study and/or Research in the US

Approximately 30 scholarships are offered each year to UK citizens for the first year of postgraduate or doctoral study, or for 'special student research'.

Benefits

Scholarships cover tuition fees and provide a living stipend for one academic year. A number of memberships, sickness and accident benefit coverage, and visa sponsorship are also included. There is substantial pre-departure support, including a Finalists Workshop (March) and a 3-day Orientation Programme (July). Once on-the-ground in the US, further support is offered by the Institute of International Education (IIE).

The following awards are offered for Postgraduate Study in the US at any US institution:

All-disciplines Postgraduate Awards: Postgraduate or doctoral study or 'special student research' in any subject.

Alastair Cooke Award in Journalism: Master's degree in Journalism or in a specialist subject leading to a career in Journalism.

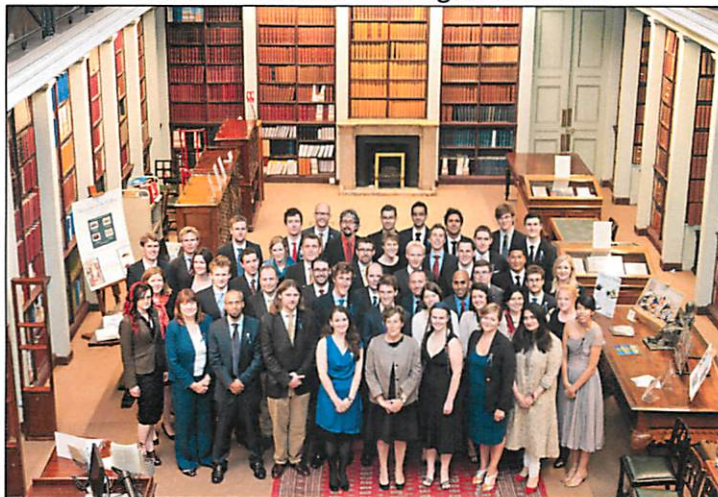
Elsevier Bibliometric Analysis Award: Postgraduate study in any interdisciplinary field requiring bibliometric analysis.

Leon Jaworski International Law Award: Master's degrees that relate directly to international law.

State Street Financial Services Award: Postgraduate study that directly relates to the financial services sector.

We also offer awards to UK citizens seeking an **MBA at Harvard** and for study or research on EU affairs, European integration or EU-US (**Schuman Award**). Both awards have different application deadlines – please see our website for more information.

- Three letters of recommendations are required.
